#### Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Takk to our members who Zoomed in for our January meeting! Takk to Thom Brownworth for his media talents and spirited effort in making virtual meetings possible! February will be a virtual meeting via Zoom. The link for the Zoom meeting is listed below.

I wish to thank the Budget Committee for their time and effort over the past few months helping to create the first Loyal Lodge Budget. The angst of something new is understandable especially when perceived unnecessary and wish to thank those members for a spirited discussion. However, the angst as to why a budget was presented for a vote at the January meeting can be explained with the following **facts**:

- By-Law Committee (Thom Brownworth, Kim Lakeman, Torun Reduto, and Oddvar Skadberg) submitted updated Loyal Lodge By-laws approved by the Loyal Lodge Membership at the March 5, 2021 Meeting. Motion to accept Michael Pedersen, seconded by Turid Mann, and passed without dissent.
- 2. Budget is in the Bylaws. Article X Committees. Section 1 It is a standing committee. By-Law Committee (Thom Brownworth, Kim Lakeman, Torun Reduto, and Oddvar Skadberg) submitted Budget Policies and Procedures and approved by the Loyal Lodge Membership at the June 6, 2021. Motion to accept Elle Supinky, seconded by Norman Christensen, and passed without dissent.
  - a. Budget is mentioned 4 times in the Policies and Procedures.
    - i. Article V Lodge Funds Section 1 Appropriations from the Lodge funds which would cause the budget line to be exceeded by more than \$1,000 shall require a two-thirds majority of votes cast for adoption. Other appropriations from the Lodge funds in excess of the Lodge budget shall require a simple majority of votes cast for adoption. In an emergency where funds are required before a regular meeting, the Executive Board shall vote on the same by simple majority of all their members.
    - ii. Article X Committees Section 1 The Budget Committee shall include the Chair, Treasurer and Financial Secretary. The Committee shall present a proposed budget to the Officers of the Lodge no later than January of each calendar year. The fiscal year shall be from February to January.
- 3. The Budget Committee submitted a proposed budget at the January meeting as per Loyal Lodge Budget Policy and Procedures.
